- 3 Knowing this, that no prophecy of Scripture comes from someone's own interpretation. For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spoke as they were moved by the Holy Ghost. 2<sup>nd</sup> Peter, chapter 1, verses 20 and 21.
- 4 Search the book of the Lord and read, nothing will be lacking. Nothing that is written will fail, for my mouth has commanded it. Isaiah, chapter 34, verse 16.

**26 - Men shall be lovers of their own selves.** 2nd Timothy, chapter 3, verses 1 to 7.

You shall not lie with a male as with a woman. Leviticus, chapter 18, verse 22 and Leviticus, chapter 20, verse 13.

27 - Women changed the natural use of sex, contrary to nature, (AIDS). Romans, chapter 1, verses 23 to 32.

28 - The works of the flesh and the fruits of the Spirit.

The flesh lusts against the spirit, and the spirit against the flesh, so that you do not do what you wish. Galatians, chapter 5, verses 16 to 21. 29 - About those who die.

- **37 About those who died in the flood.** Genesis, chapter 7, verses 17 to 24.
- 38 Meaning of the rainbow.

God made a covenant with Noah.

I have set my bow in the cloud; it will be a sign of the covenant between me and the earth. Genesis, chapter 9, verses 8 to 17.

39 - Satan wanted to be like God.

God does not share his glory with nobody. Isaiah, chapter 14, verses 9 to 16.

You were anointed guardian cherub. You lifted up your heart because of your beauty, and for the multitude of your iniquities. Ezekiel, chapter 28, verses 13 to 19.

40 - The Great Day of the Lord is close.

Neither their silver, nor their gold will deliver them from wrath of the Lord. Zephaniah, chapter 1, verses 14 to 18.

41 - God repented that he had made man. And the LORD said I will destroy man, whom I have created, for it repents me that I have made them. Genesis, chapter 6, verses 5 to 7.

- 48 Not everyone will be saved, only those whom God choose.
- So, it is not of him that will, not of him that run, but from God that shows mercy. Romans, chapter 9, verses 14 to 16.
- 49 Jesus said you did not choose me, but I chose you. No one chooses Jesus Christ, by raising their hands, but the Lord Jesus who chooses us. John, chapter 15, verse 16.
- 50 It pleased God to save the believers.

1st Corinthians, chapter 1, verses 19 to 21.

51 - The parable of the wheat and the tares.

Matthew, chapter 13, verses 24 to 30, and verses 36 to 43.

**52 - Flesh and blood will not inherit the kingdom of God.** 1st Corinthians, chapter 15, verse 50.

Then the dust will return to the earth as it was: and the spirit, will return unto God who gave it. Ecclesiastes, chapter 12, verse 7.

**53 - The unrighteous will not Inherit the kingdom of heaven.** 1st Corinthians, chapter 6, verses 9 to 11.

- **54 Many who sleeps in the dust of the earth will rise, some to eternal life, and others to shame and everlasting contempt.** Daniel, chapter 12, verses 2 and 3.
- **55 Those who have done good will come out into eternal life, and those who did evil to eternal damnation.** John, chapter 5, verses 24 to 29.

  The people were astonished at His doctrine. Matthew, chapter 7, verse 28.

The whole crowd was astonished at his doctrine. Mark, chapter 11, verses 17 and 18.

They admired his doctrine, because his word was with authority. Luke, chapter 4, verse 32.

Jesus said: My doctrine is not mine, but of whom sent me (God). John, chapter 7, verses 13 to 18.

Whoever does not follow the doctrine of Christ does not have the father neither the Son. 2<sup>nd</sup> John, chapter 1, verses 9 to 11.

Those who do not follow the doctrine of Jesus Christ deceives people's hearts with words and flatteries. Romans, chapter 16, verses 16 to 18.

57 - There are several doctrines, but the best known are:

**Doctrine of the apostles: Which was left by Jesus Christ.** Acts, chapter 2, verse 42.

**Doctrine of Men:** Matthew, chapter 15, verses 7 to 9, and Mark, chapter 7, verses 6 to 9.

And doctrine of devils: 1st Timothy, chapter 4, verse 1.

58 - The doctrine of devils is the one that has most deceives people. I don't want you to be participants with the devils. 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians, chapter 10, verses 19 to 21.

For doctrine of devils is completely contrary to God's will. 2<sup>nd</sup> Thessalonians, chapter 2, verses 1 to 11.

59 - Fellowship with devils and not with God.

You cannot drink the cup of the Lord and the cup of devils. 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians, chapter 10, verses 14 to 21.

**60 - Do not repeat prayers. Do not use vain repetitions.** Matthew, chapter 6, verses 5 to 8.

### 61 - About prayer.

At the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven on earth and under the earth. Philippians, chapter. 2 verses 9 and 10.

As surely as I live, says the Lord, every knee will bow before me and every tongue will acknowledge God. Romans, chapter 14, verses 11 and 12.

It is God's oath that every knee will bow before him. Isaiah, chapter 45, verses 22 and 23.

To speak with God, we must kneel and to speak with men we remain standing. Acts, chapter 10, verse 20 to 26.

Jesus prayed in his knees. Luke, chapter 22, verse 39 to 46.

All the apostles used to pray on their knees and salute one another with the holy kiss. Acts, chapter 20, verses 33 to 36.

We kneel before the Lord who created us. Psalms, chapter 95, verse 6. I love them that love me; and those that seek me early will find me. Proverbs, chapter 8, verse 17.

Even Satan asked the Lord Jesus to prostrate himself before him. Matthew, chapter 4, verses 8 and 10.

When you pray do not be like hypocrites who pray standing in churches, and on street corners to be seen by men. Matthew, chapter 6, verse 5.

# **62 - Kneeling in Prayer.**

**Solomon did kneel to pray.** 2nd Chronicles, chapter 6, verse 13.

Ezra used to pray on his knees. Ezra, chapter 9, verse 5.

Daniel used to pray on his knees. Daniel, chapter 6, verse 10.

Solomon used to pray on his knees. 1st Kings, chapter 8, verse 54.

Shulamite used to pray on her knees. 2nd Kings, chapter 4, verses 37.

Paul prayed kneeling on the beach. Acts, chapter 21, verse 5.

Peter prayed on his knees. Acts, chapter 9, verse 40.

**Stephen prayed on his knees before he died.** Acts, chapter 7, verse 60. **Jesus prayed on his knees.** Luke, chapters 22, verses 39 to 46.

#### 63 - About the veil.

How sisters should present themselves in the churches.

If the Hair were a veil as some argue, God would not have said, by the scriptures, that women must wear the veil, and the man would be born bald. for the scriptures testify that it is dishonorable for a man to

cover himself, and have long hair. In urgent cases, where the woman is not in a position to use the veil, such as in streets and public places, by the mercy of God, on this occasion the hair will serve as a veil.

However, one substitute will never be like the holder. 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians, chapter 11, verses 2 to 16.

64 - The Veil, and Long Hair.

**Rebecca took the veil and covered herself.** Genesis, chapter 24, verses 64 and 65.

The sinner woman watered the Lord Jesus' feet with her tears and she wiped them with the hairs of his head. Luke, chapter 7, verse 38.

65 - About Holy Supper.

The Passover was served once a year, so the same must be done with the Holy Supper, which is the Passover substitute. Exodus, chapter 13, verse 10.

Holy Supper of Jesus Christ. 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians, chapter 11, verses 17 to 30. No chapter or verse in the bible reports that is to be remembered the birth of the Lord Jesus, but rather his death must be remembered. 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians, chapter 11, verses 25 and 26.

Every year there is a commemoration of sins. Hebrews, chapter 10, verses 3.

No one is born or dies once a month, twelve times a year. In the same way, the Lord Jesus was born and died once.

Therefore, the memory of his death must be remembered once a year, by the holy supper.

- **66 The one to whom I will give this piece of bread, when I have dipped it in the dish, that one will betray me.** John, chapter 13, verses 21 to 30.
- **67 Greetings with the Peace of God.** 1<sup>st</sup> Timothy, chapter 1, verse 2. Titus, chapter 1, verse 4. And Colossians, chapter 1, verse 2.
- 68 Greetings with the Holy kiss.

It is written, several times in the Old Testament that men and women of God used to greet each other with the Holy Kiss. Genesis, chapter 27, verses 26 and 27. Genesis, chapter 45, verse 15. Exodus, chapter 4, verses 27. Exodus, chapter 18, verses 7. 1st Samuel, chapter 10, verses 1.

1<sup>st</sup> Samuel, chapter 20, verses 41. 1<sup>st</sup> Kings, chapter 19, verses 20. Ruth, chapter 1, verse 14. Proverbs, chapter 24, verses 26.

Dictionary meaning of holy kiss:

A holy kiss is one that is not disingenuous or deceitful, contrary to Judas' kiss to betray Jesus. Rather, a holy kiss, between Christians, is to express brotherly love, and unity. A holy kiss, communicates familial closeness, and fellowship.

Kiss the Son of God, lest he perish, on the way, and ignite his wrath. Psalms, chapter 2, verse 12.

God and his son, Jesus Christ, were the first to salute with a holy kiss. Psalms, chapter 85, verses 10 to 13.

The price of betrayal. Matthew, chapter 26, verses 14 to 16. I greet you with a kiss (sign). Matthew, chapter 26, verses 47 to 50. Jesus Christ himself asked for the holy kiss. Luke, chapter 7, verses 36 to 45.

They embraced the Apostle Paul and greeted him with a kiss. Acts, chapter 20, verses 33 to 37.

Greet one another with a holy kiss, but there are those who cause offences, with soft words, confounding the hearts of simple, these do not serve the Lord Jesus Christ. Romans, chapter 16, verse 16 to 18. 2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians, chapter 13, verses 12. 1<sup>st</sup> Thessalonians, chapter 5, verse 26. Christ is the head of the church. Ephesians, chapter 5, verses 22 and 23.

Universal epistle of the apostle Peter:

Peter wrote this doctrine, to the whole world, (universal). 1<sup>st</sup> Peter, chapter 5, verses 14.

69 - Greetings with the Holy Kiss, and the peace of God.

Behold, I leave my peace. John, chapter 14, verse 27. Philippians,

chapter 4, verses 7. Colossians, Chapter 3, verse 15.

The Peace is from God.

Romans, chapter 1, verse 7.

1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians, chapter 1, verse 3. 2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians, chapter 1, verse 2. Galatians, chapter 1, verse 3. Ephesians, chapter 1, verse 2. 1<sup>st</sup> Timothy, chapter 1, verse 2.

**70 - Jesus Christ said, "I did not bring peace". Jesus brought the word.** Matthew, chapter 10, verses 34 to 38

71 - Anyone who welcomes them has part in their wicked work. If anyone comes to you and does not bring the doctrine of Christ, salute them not, for he who salutes has part in their evil works. 2nd John, chapter 1, verses 8 to 11.

72 - About Baptism.

I am not come to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance. Matthew, chapter 9, verses 10 to 13.

Repent then, and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped out. Acts, Chapter 3, verse 19.

Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; Isaiah, chapter 1, verses 16 to 20.

I will forgive your transgressions and remembers your sins no more. Isaiah, chapter 43, verse 25.

Come to the waters, though you have no money, because salvation is free. Isaiah, chapter 55, verses 1 and 2.

For I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more. Jeremias, chapter 31, verses 33 to 35.

Baptism of Jesus Christ. Matthew, chapter 3, verses 13 to 17.

Whoever believes and is baptized, will be saved but whoever does not believe will be condemned. Mark, chapter 16, verses 15 and 16.

No one can see the kingdom of God, unless they are born again. John, chapter 3, verses 1 to 8.

Whoever is not born again cannot see the kingdom of God. John, chapter 3, verses 1 to 8.

One baptism. Ephesians, chapter 4, verse 5.

For I will be merciful, and your sins I will remember no more. Hebrews, chapter 8, verses 12 and 13.

**Baptism in the name of the father.** Matthew chapter 28 verses 16 to 20. **The First conversions.** Acts, chapter 2, verses 37 to 39.

**To convert and become like a child.** Matthew, chapter 18, verses 1 to 5. **Philip baptized the Eunuch.** Acts, chapter 8, verses 26 to 39.

The Baptism of Paul. Acts, chapter 9, verses 1 to 18.

Whoever baptized John's baptism had to baptize again. Acts chapter 19, verses 1 to 6.

Effeminate, thieves, drunkards will not inherit the God's kingdom. 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians, chapter 6, verses 9 to 11.

If anyone is in Christ, he is a new creature. The old things have passed away and everything has become new. 2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians, chapter 5, verse 17.

73 - Baptism for salvation and forgiveness of sins is valid just if it is done in the name of the Lord Jesus.

The Baptism of Jesus. Luke, chapter 3, verse 21 and 22.

And that by believing, you may have life in his name. John, chapter 20, verse 31.

There is no other name that gives salvation, but just the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. Acts, chapter 4, verses 10 to 12.

The souls that were baptized in the baptism of John (repentance), had to be baptized again, into the baptism of Jesus Christ (for forgiveness of sins). Acts, chapter 19, verse 1 to 6.

And they will receive forgiveness of sins, through his name. Acts, chapter 10, verses 42 and 43.

Whatever you do, in word or deed, do all in name of the Lord Jesus Christ. Colossians, chapter 3, verse 17.

John the Baptist said, I baptize with water for the repentance. Matthew, chapter 3, verses 1 to 12.

The Baptism of Jesus Christ. Matthew, chapter 3, verses 13 to 17. In his name you preached repentance. Luke chapter 24 verse 47. Jesus instructs Nicodemus about the new birth. John, chapter 3, verses 1 to 13.

Repent, every one of you, and be baptized in Name of our Lord Jesus Christ, for the forgiveness of sins. Acts, chapter 2, verse 37 to 39.

Can any man forbid water? And he commanded them to be baptized in the name of the Lord. Acts, chapter 10, verses 47 and 48.

To die unto sin so it can have life with God. Romans, chapter 6, verses 3 to 10.

74 - To assume his ministry, Jesus Christ fulfilled the law. From the age of thirty years and upwards until the age of fifty, everyone who entered the ministry had to be baptized. Numbers, chapter 4, verses 35; 39 and 47.

Jesus baptized when he was almost thirty years old. Luke, chapter 3, verses 21 to 23.

75 - About sins after baptism.

And sin when it is finished, it leads to death. James, chapter 1, verses 12 to 16.

**76 - There is sin that leads to death, and for that, I do not say pray.** 1<sup>st</sup> John, chapter 5, verses 16 to 19.

77 - The just will live by faith: but if any man draw back, God is not pleased on him. Hebrews, chapter 10, verses 37 to 39.

Not leaving your congregation as it is custom of some. Hebrews, chapter 10, verses 21 to 27.

78 - The soul that sins will die.

The sins of some men are manifest before the judgment, and some after. 1st Timothy, Chapter 5, verse 24.

The day when God will judge the secrets of men. Romans, chapter 2, verse 16.

He who saves a soul will cover a multitude of sins. James, chapter 5, verses 19 and 20.

The soul that sins will die. Ezekiel, chapter 18, verse 4.

Son doesn't save father and father doesn't save son. Ezekiel, chapter 18, verses 20 to 31.

When a righteous man turns away from his righteousness by doing iniquity, all his righteousness will not be remembered, but in his iniquity that he does, he will die. Ezekiel, chapter 33, verses 11 to 20. The eyes of the Lord will seek the faithful of the earth, and he who uses deceit will not remain within his house. Psalms, chapter 101, verses 6 and 7.

79 - Whoever sins, God blots out his name from the book of life. The Lord said to Moses, whoever has sinned against me, I will blot out of my book. Exodus, chapter 32, verses 30 to 33.

80 - The pastors.

**keep yourself of dogs, and evil workers.** Philippians, chapter 3, verse 2. Isaiah, chapter 56, verses 10 and 11.

In the Last Judgment, all who worked for wages will be sad in their souls. Isaiah, chapter 19, verses 9 and 10.

They are rebels and companions of thieves and run after wages. Isaiah, chapter 1, verse 23.

You eat the fat and you clothe yourselves with the wool of the sheep. Ezekiel, chapter 34, verses 1 to 5.

Dogs and everyone who loves and commits lies will be left outside. Revelation, chapter 22, verse 15.

Woe to pregnant women and those who suckle (pregnant with lies and those who suckle with lies). Matthew, chapter 24, verse1 to 19. Woe to the pastors, who destroy the sheep of my pasture. Jeremiah, chapter 23, verses 1 to 4 and verses 11 and 12.

It is to live by the gospel and not eat from the gospel, Corinthians, chapter 9, verse 14. Matthew, chapter 10, verses 5 to 10 and Lucas, chapter 10 verses 2 to 8.

Paul did not charge anything to preach the gospel. 2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians, chapter 12, verses 12 to 18.

Live working with your own business and with your own hands.

Thessalonians, chapter 4, verses 11 and 12.

If someone doesn't want to work, he should not eat too.

Thessalonians, chapter 3, verses 8 to 10.

They are shepherds who understanding nothing; they all go after their own way, they seek their own gain, each one for his own share. Isaiah, chapter 56, verses 10 and 11.

Do not give holy things to dogs. Matthew, chapter 7, verse 6.

I have other sheep which are not of this fold. John, chapter 10, verses 1 to 16.

The way of truth shall be evil spoken of. 2<sup>nd</sup> Peter, chapter 2, verses 1 to 22.

Obey he who has the gifts of shepherd and not he that has the title. Hebrews, chapter 13, verses 17 to 20.

Weep, wail and roll in the ashes, you shepherds; Jeremiah, chapter 25, verses 34 to 38.

Jesus Christ ascended to heaven and he left the gift of pastor, but the man went to seek the knowledge and title in earthly studies. Ephesian, chapter 4, verses 4 to 11.

For the wisdom of this world is madness in God's sight. 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians, chapter 3, verse 18 and 19.

The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom. Proverbs, chapter 9, verse 10.

The fear of the Lord is wisdom; and to depart from evil is understanding. Job, chapter 28, verse 28.

81 - Those who devour widows' houses will receive greater condemnation. Look after the cause of the widow. Isaiah chapter 1 verses 17.

Pretending make long prayers. Mark, chapter 12, verses 38 to 40.

They will receive greater damnation. Luke, chapter 20, verses 45 to 47.

82 - About false prophets.

Priests teach for a price and prophets prophesy for money. Micah, chapter 3, verses 5 to 11.

**83 - The way of truth shall be evil spoken of.** 2<sup>nd</sup> Peter, chapter 2, verses 1 to 4.

One Lord, one faith, one baptism; Ephesians, chapter 4, verses 4 to 11. 84 - Give for free.

It can't be charged to baptize, come to the waters; without money and without cost. Isaiah, chapter 55, verses 1 to 3.

Freely you have received; freely you give. Matthew, chapter 10, verses 6 to 8.

85 - Church collections must be voluntary and without a stipulated value.

As God hath prospered him, 1st Corinthians, chapter 16, verses 1 and 2. The one who gathered much did not have too much, and the one who gathered little did not have too little. 2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians, chapter 8, verses 15 to 17.

**86 - The wages of those who preach the gospel is the crown of everlasting life.** Isaiah, chapter 40, verses 9 to 11.

The fruit of the righteous is tree of life and he who wins souls is wise. Proverbs, chapter 11, verse 30.

Those who much teach righteousness will shine as the brightness of the firmament. Daniel, chapter 12, verse 3.

He that convert the sinner from the error of his way will save a soul from death. James, chapter 5, verse 20.

87 - Tithe was created according to Old Testament law.

Abraham paid tithes, circumcised Isaac, and made burnt offerings. Genesis, chapter 14, verses 18 to 20.

The law lasted until John the Baptist. Matthew, chapter 11, verse 13. My yoke is easy and my burden is light. Matthew, chapter 11, verses 25 to 30.

Jesus paid tribute (tax). Matthew, chapter 17, verses 24 to 27.

Woe to you who tithe mint, anise and cumin, and despise the most important matters of the law, judgment, mercy and faith. Matthew, chapter 23, verse 23.

Woe to you Doctors of the Law, who loads men with burdens grievous to be borne and you yourselves don't even touch this load with your finger. Luke, chapter 11, verses 44 to 46.

The law and prophets lasted until John the Baptist. Luke, chapter 16, verses 16 to 17.

For the Law and the prophets lasted until John, but grace came through Jesus Christ. John, chapter 1, verse 17.

Take away the Old Testament to establish the New one. Hebrews, chapter 10, verse 9.

88 - They only paid tithes from Abraham up to Levi.

Jesus Christ came after Levi, that's why tithes is no longer paid. Hebrews, chapter 7, verses 7 to 9.

89 - The tithe was canceled.

**Disannulling means invalid; canceled.** Hebrews, chapter 7, verses 17 to 19.

90 - Tithe was part of the law.

By the law no one will be justified by God for all those who are of the works of the law, are under the curse of sin. Galatians, chapter 3, verses 10 to 13.

91 - Women cannot preach in churches.

I do not permit a woman to teach or to assume authority over a man. 1<sup>st</sup> Timothy, chapter 2, verses 9 to 14.

It was God who commanded the apostle Paul to write this letter to the church at Corinthians. 1st Corinthians, chapter 14, verses 34 to 38.

Women used to help the apostle Paul to evangelize, but they did not preach from behind a pulpit (women cannot preach in church). Lord Jesus had no woman as an Apostle. Philippians, chapter 4, verse 3.

#### 92 - Elder in the churches.

Elders were elected in each church. Acts chapter. 14 verse 23. The elders and important leaders are the head, the prophets who teach lies are the tail. Isaiah, chapter 9, verse 15 and 16. Acts, chapter, 20 verses 17 to 38.1st Timothy, chapter 3. 1st Peter, chapter 5, verses 1 to 4.

In Roman language he who used to preside over them was called bishop, which means elder. In Greek language he who used to preside over them was called presbyter, which also means elder.

### 93 - Cooperator in the church

Those who cooperate have no salary. The salary is crown of eternal life. Romans, chapter 16, verse 21. 1st Corinthians chapter 3 verse 9. Colossians, chapter 4, verse 11. Philemon, chapter, verse 24.

94 - Upon this rock I will build my church (The rock was Jesus Christ and not Peter).

When Jesus referred to the Rock, He was speaking of himself. Matthew chapter 16 verses 16 to 20.

**Jesus Christ is the chief cornerstone.** Ephesians, chapter 2, verses 19 to 22.

Jesus is the stone you builders rejected, which has become the cornerstone. Acts, chapter 4, verses 10 to 12.

95 - About marriage.

Whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven. Matthew, chapter 18, verse 18.

God unites only in the flesh; He does not unite in the spirit. Matthew, chapter 19, verses 3 to 5.

For in the resurrection, they neither marry nor are given in marriage, but are like the angels of God in heaven. Matthew, chapter 22, verses 25 to 30.

The wife does not have authority over her own body, but the husband does. Likewise, the husband does not have authority over his own body, but the wife does. 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians, chapter 7, verse 4.

The wife is bound by the law. Corinthians, chapter 7, verse 39.

For the woman who has a husband is bound by the law. Romans, chapter 7, verses 1 to 3.

God joins, by the marriage, only in the flesh. God doesn't join the spirits. If it were so, when the man would die the woman would die too. Therefore, there would be no widow or widower on earth. In this perspective, salvation would not be individual, but conjugal (the couple). The church is for spiritual services not for carnal ones.

96 - Marriage to strangers to the faith.

Do not be unequally yoked together with unbelievers.

2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians, chapter 6, verses 13 to 18.

97 - About adultery.

To avoid fornication, let every man have his own wife, and let every woman have her own husband. 1st Corinthians, chapter 7, verses 1 to 4. 98 - Jesus Christ rebuked a woman who praised Mary his mother. Rather, blessed are they that hear the word of God, and keep it. Luke chapter 11 verses 27 and 28.

99 - Pope, Priest on the church.

The bishops must be blameless, husband of one wife.

1<sup>st</sup> Timothy, chapter 3, verses 1 to 13.

Men who speak lies, forbidding marriage and commanding abstinence (forbidding the relationship between a man and a woman united by marriage), for everything God created is good, and nothing is to be rejected. 1st Timothy chapter 1, verses 1 to 4.

100 - About procession.

Those who lead processions and graven images know nothing; they pray to a god who cannot save. Isaiah, chapter 45, verse 15 to 22.

The birth of Jesus Christ. Luke chapter 1 verses 26 and 31.

101 - Cursed is everyone who is hanged on a tree.

The cross symbolizes death. Galatians, chapter 3, verses 10 to 13.

102 - The Host can never take away sins.

The same sacrifices, which can never take away sins. Hebrews, chapter 10, verses 10 to 13.

103 - Mary, the mother of Jesus Christ had several sons and daughters.

I am a foreigner to my own family, a stranger to my own mother's children. Psalm, chapter 69, verses 8.

Jesus family. Matthew, Chapter 12, verses 46 to 50.

And the names of the brothers of Jesus were James, Joseph, Simon and Judas, and there were also sisters that the bible does not mention their names. Matthew, chapter 13, verses 53 to 58.

**Jesus' brothers did not believe in him.** Mark, chapter 6, verses 1 to 4. John, chapter 7, verses 1 to 5.

104 - About Babylon.

Come out of her, my people, that ye be not partakers of her sins. Revelation, chapter 18, verses 1 to 6.

Behold, the days are coming when I will visit the graven images of Babylon. Jeremiah, chapter 51, verses 6 to 9. Jeremiah, chapter 51, verses 47 and 48.

And in her was found the blood of the prophets and of all that were slain on the earth. Revelation, chapter 18, verses 21 to 24.

105 - About graven images.

No one has ascended to heaven except the Lord Jesus Christ. John chapter 3 verses 12 and 13.

There is only one mediator between God and man, Jesus Christ. 1<sup>st</sup> Timothy, chapter 2, verses 4 and 5.

106 - About canonization.

Nobody becomes a saint. The righteous are only saved.

If only the righteous are saved, where will the wicked and the sinner appear? 1st Peter, chapter 4, verses 17 and 18.

107 - They that make graven images are like the image; so is every one that trust in these images. Psalms, chapter 115, verses 1 to 11.

All image followers will be confused. Isaiah, chapter 44, verses 8 to 20.

Those who carry their graven images in procession pray to a god who cannot save. Isaiah, chapter 45, verses 20 to 22.

They bring silver and gold hammered by the craftsman and the founder, carving an image, Violet and purple are their clothing. (Observe verse 9). What would that image be? Jeremiah, chapter 10, verses 1 to 15.

The graven image is a lie and there is no spirit in any of them. Jeremiah, chapter 51, verse 15 to 18.

108 - Other references about graven images.

I shall not make for you any graven image or any likeness of anything that is in heaven above or that is in the earth below or that is in the water under the earth. Deuteronomy, chapter 5, verses 8 and 9.

Cursed be the man who makes a graven image. Deuteronomy, chapter 27, verse 15.

They have a mouth, but they don't speak, they have eyes, but they don't see. Psalms, chapter 135, verses 15 to 18.

All their followers will be confused. Isaiah, chapter 2, verses 18 to 20. Isaiah, chapter 44, verses 9 to 19.

God created light and darkness. He created evil and also peace. Isaiah, chapter 45, verses 5, 6, 9, 14, 16, 18 and 20.

The graven image that teaches the lie. Habakkuk chapter 2, verses 18 and 19.

**Abstain from the contaminants of idols.** Acts, chapter 15, verse 20 and 1st John, chapter 5, verse 21.

Idolatry, witchcraft, murder, and things like these, those who commit such things will not inherit the kingdom of God. Galatians, chapter 5, verses 19 to 21.

109 - I shall not make for you any graven image or any likeness of anything that is in heaven above or that is in the earth below.

Deuteronomy, chapter 5, verses 7 to 11.

**110 - Eat everything sold in the butchery.** 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians, chapter 10, verses 20 to 25.

111 - Strangled meat.

Animal slaughtered without pouring its blood; his meat has not been properly drained of its blood.

But the meat with its life, that is, with its blood, you shall not eat. Genesis, chapter 9, verses 1 to 6.

**Don't eat the blood, because blood is life.** Deuteronomy, chapter 12, verses 23 and 24.

**Abstain from things sacrificed to idols and from blood.** Acts, chapter 15, verses 20 and 29.

Abstain from food sacrificed to idols, from blood, from the meat of strangled animals, and from fornication. Acts, chapter 21, verse 25.

112 - Sorcerers, magicians, healers, diviners, fortune tellers, prognosticators. (God does not allow such things). Deuteronomy, chapter 18, verses 9 to 14.

113 - About the beast and the number 666.

Here is wisdom. Let him who has understanding calculate the number of the beast, for it is the number of a man: His number is 666.

Revelation, chapter 13, verses 13 to 18.

**He blasphemes against God.** Revelation, chapter 13, verses 4 to 10. And Revelation, chapter 17, verses 9 to 11.

114 - Anyone not found written in the book of life will be thrown into a lake of fire. Revelation, chapter 20, verses 11 to 15.

115 - About Sabbath.

God has abolished solemn feasts and Sabbaths. Lamentations, chapter 2, verse 6.

**Jesus Christ is the lord even of the sabbath day.** Matthew, chapter 12, verses 1 to 8.

May the blood of Jesus Christ be on us and our children. Matthew, chapter 27, verses 24 and 25.

If an animal falls into a pit on the sabbath day, won't you pull it out right away? You will let him die? Luke, chapter 14, verses 1 to 5.

My Father is always working, and so am I. John, chapter 5, verses 1 to 17.

Let no one therefore judge you in eating, or in drinking, or with respect to a feast day or a Sabbath day. Colossians, chapter 2, verses 16 and 17.

By the law no one will be justified by God, for all those who are of the works of the law are under the curse. Galatians, chapter 3, verses 10 to 13.

There is rest for God's people, but no specific day has been set, as the rest will be in the glory with God. Hebrews, chapter 4, verses 1 to 13.

**Jesus Christ even of the Sabbath is Lord.** Mark, chapter 2, verses 27 and 28.

Neither Jesus Christ nor the Holy Spirit nor the apostles taught about keeping the Sabbath. Romans, chapter 13, verses 8 to 10. And Galatians, chapter 5, verse 14.

The Apostle James said that if anyone keeps the whole law and fails in one point, he has become guilty of all. James, chapter 2, verse 10. If anyone is in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new. 2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians, chapter 5, verse 17.

The apostle Paul rebuked those who wanted to keep days, and months, and times, and years. Galatians, chapter 4, verses 9 to 11. The law was our teacher to lead us to Christ. Galatians, chapter 3, verses 23 to 27.

The apostles regarded every day the same. They used not to keep the seventh day. Romans, chapter 14, verses 5 and 6.

For the end of the law is Christ, for the righteousness of everyone that believes. Whoever is in Christ does not fail in one point of the law, because Christ it is the light to guide them. John, chapter 11, verses 9 and 10.

It is no longer I who live, it is Christ who lives in me. Galatians, chapter 2, verses 19 to 21.

If I'm in Christ, He won't let me fail, I keep all the commandments which He commands me to keep. And rest in Him, for He is the day that the Lord has made, for my joy, for my rest and for my refreshment. Psalms, chapter 118, verses 18 to 24.

Those who receive a salary to preach and are registered as preachers, to preach is their job and on sabbath days it is the day when they most work. So, even they don't keep the Sabbath.

116 - Alcoholic drinks.

As I told you before, those who do such things will not inherit the kingdom of heaven. Galatians, chapter 5, verses 16 to 21. And 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians, chapter 6, verses 8 to 11.

Wine is scorner and will never be wise whosoever is deceived by it. Proverbs, chapter 20, verse 1.

Don't be among the drunkards. Proverbs, chapter 23, verses 19 to 23. Your eyes will look at strange women and you will lust after them. Proverbs, chapter 23, verses 29 to 33.

Woe unto them that rise up early in the morning, that they may follow strong drink until the night. Isaiah, chapter 5, verses 11, 22 and 23.

Even the prophet and the priest err because of strong drink. Isaiah, chapter 28, verses 6 to 11.

Don't be drunk with wine, because that will ruin your life. Instead, be filled with the Holy Spirit. Ephesians, chapter 5, verse 18.

John the Baptist drank neither wine nor strong drink and was filled with the Holy Spirit. Luke, chapter 1, verses 12 to 16.

**Strong drinks are for those who perish.** Proverbs, chapter 31, verses 4 to 8.

117 - About marks on the body (Tattoos).

You shall not make any cuttings in your flesh for the dead, nor print any marks upon you: I am the LORD. Leviticus, chapter 19, verse 28. They shall not make baldness upon their head, neither shall they shave off the corner of their beard, nor make any cuttings in their flesh. Leviticus, chapter 21, verse 5.

Our body is the temple and dwelling place of the Holy Spirit, if anyone destroys the temple of God, God will destroy him. 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians, chapter 3, verses 16 and 17.

The trends of the world make man lose the image and likeness of **God.** 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians, chapter 6, verses 19 and 20.

118 - About riches.

There will be few who will enter the kingdom of heaven. Because some of the rich trust more in their riches than in God. Mark, chapter 10, verses 23 to 31.

**Tonight, your soul will be required of you.** Luke, chapter 12, verses 13 to 21.

119 - About those who go from house to house preaching the gospel. Having an outward form of religion godliness, but they deny its power because their conduct nullifies their claim of faith. 2nd Timothy, chapter 3.

The way of life leads upward the wise, that he may depart from hell beneath. Proverbs, chapter 15, verse 24.

120 - More references on who preaches the gospel from house to house.

A belial witness scorns judgment (check belial meaning). Proverbs, chapter 19, verse 28

In my Father's house there are many rooms. I am going to prepare a place for you. John, chapter 14, verses 1 to 5.

We are citizens of heaven. Philippians, chapter 3, verses 17 to 20.

Think about the things of heaven. Colossians, chapter 3, verses 1 to 5.

For we know that when this earthly tent we live in is destroyed, we will have a house in heaven made for us by God. 2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians, chapter 5, verses 1 to 10.

The heavens shall pass away with a great noise. 2<sup>nd</sup> Peter, chapter 3. Satan, who deceives the whole world; he was thrown down to the earth, and his angels were thrown down with him. Revelation, chapter 12, verse 9.

121 - Those who serve God their days will be added, the wicked will have their days shortened.
